Survey of Likely 2026 General Election Voters **National**

March 3 – 5, 2025 | n=1500 | $\pm 2.51\%$

Insights & Analysis

- Nearly half (47%) of voters **approve of Donald Trump's job performance**, a slight dip from February as a majority of **swing voters** previously approved of his job performance, but now stand at 43% approve, 52% disapprove. The intensity of the political realignment from November **appears to be coming back to earth** as Trump's approval was previously **42% among Black men** and **now stands at 30%**, and 27% have a favorable opinion of him (down from 40% last month).
- **Trump's image** (47% fav, 52% unfav) remains strong despite a slight drop in net favorability since February, where his image was the strongest since Cygnal started the National Voter Trend survey (NVT). Trump's image and job approval are continually bolstered by the fact that **voters support the actions his administration** has taken recently.
- Very consistent with the past few surveys, **only 40% of voters have a favorable image of Democrats in Washington** compared to **54%** who hold an unfavorable view of the caucuses led by Chuck Schumer and Hakeem Jeffries. **Joe Biden's image** remains consistent at 40% fav, 55% unfav.
- **Favorability of congressional Republicans has slipped**, now standing at 44% favorable, 52% unfavorable (compared to 47% favorable, 48% unfavorable in February). Their image decreased among those getting news from **social media, non-college men, and young** voters.
- 45% believe the **U.S. is headed in the right direction**, showing the second straight month with the highest level of optimism in the country we've seen since the NVT began.
 - Similarly, **42% believe things in the U.S. are getting better** vs 53% who say they are getting worse.
 - In contrast, **just 27% believe things in the world are getting better** compared to nearly two-thirds (64%) who believe things in the world are getting worse. **Republicans are the most optimistic group**, but still stand at 42% better, 46% worse.

Insights & Analysis

- The previous **GOP lead** (R+1) on the 2026 **generic congressional ballot** has **fallen to a Democratic lead** (+1). Non-college men and swing voters drove the shift to a Democrat.
- **Continued attacks of Elon Musk** in the media and among Congressional Democrats is having more of a negative impact (42 fav, 53 unfav) as **his image continues to fall more net negative** (43 fav, 50 unfav in February). Swing voters have soured since last month (-14 net fav).
- **NATO** (55 fav, 28 unfav) is favorable outside of Republicans (37 fav, 46 unfav), and the **U.N.** (53 fav, 35 unfav) has a slightly worse image, again driven by Republicans (31 fav, 55 unfav).
- The **U.S.** (71 fav, 26 unfav) is beloved despite Democrats (52 fav, 45 unfav) barely having a net favorable image of their own country.
 - **Russia** (11 fav, 79 unfav), **Iran** (7 fav, 75 unfav), and **China** (13 fav, 75 unfav), are each unfavorable to at least three-quarters of voters.
- Among all the issues Trump has handled thus far, his handling of **illegal immigration** stands out as the **most approved**, while his handling of **inflation and the cost of living** are **most disapproved**.
- Views on Trump's executive order to **require all federal agencies to be directly accountable to the President** mixed (42% support, 46% oppose). Independents stand at 2:1 oppose to support.
- Support for Trump's executive order to **reinstate Title 42** is more supported (48% support, 34% oppose) with Independents and swing voters supporting overall.
- Nearly a majority also **support President Trump's initiative to engage in direct negotiations with Russian President Vladimir Putin** to seek a resolution to the ongoing war in Ukraine (48% support, 40% oppose). Swing voters support this action (45% support, 33% oppose).

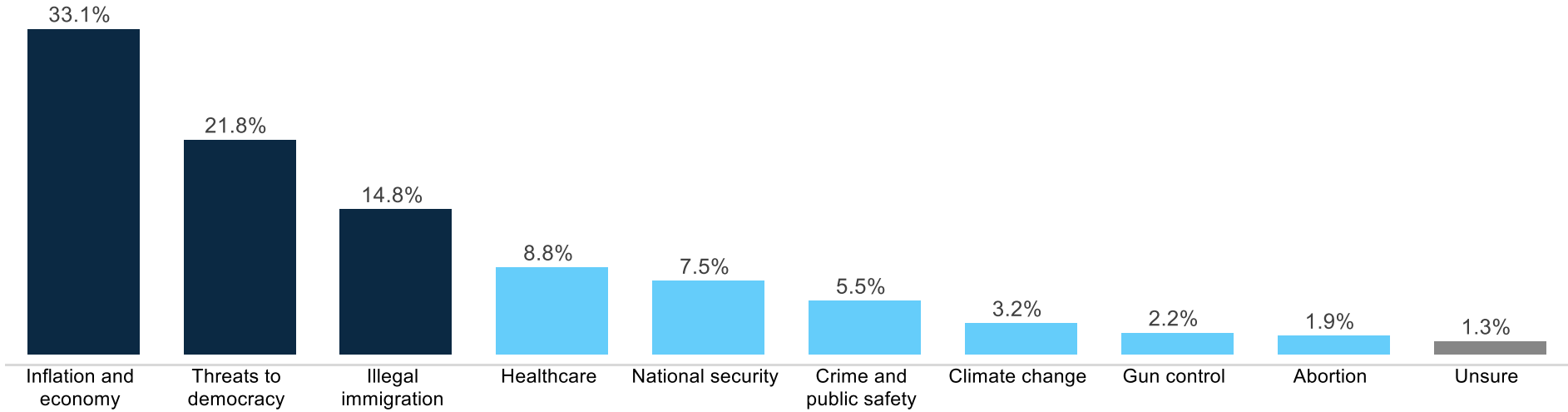
Insights & Analysis

- Similarly, 48% support President Trump's executive order **emphasizing the protection of Second Amendment rights** (34% oppose). Both Independents and swing voters support overall.
- Trump's executive order to **withdraw the United States from and cessation of funding to specific United Nations organizations is more contested** (43% support, 44% oppose) as Independents as swing voters oppose this issue compared to the other actions taken.
- When deciding who to support for Congress, a majority of voters believe **a candidate's stance on other issues aside from Medicaid cuts are the most important factor** in their support. 34% believe Medicaid cuts are the most important factor, including 44% of Black voters.
 - Black (17%) and Hispanic (15%) voters are most likely to receive **health coverage from Medicaid** compared to 5% of white voters. Medicaid recipients are also the least likely to have a strong voting history.
 - **70%** of voters claim to have a personal, family, or friend **connection to Medicaid** services.
- Opinions are mixed on the **effectiveness of international non-government organizations** in addressing global challenges (39% effective, 43% ineffective).
- Nearly 6-in-10 voters believe that over the next five years, **personal economic opportunities are strongest inside the U.S. vs abroad**.
 - Voters tend to associate the U.S. with **military superpower** (66%), **economic opportunity** (59%), and **global leadership** (51%).
 - Two thirds also believe the **U.S. is the world's leading superpower over China** (21%).
 - Voters believe the U.S. should either play a **leading role** (43%) or **supporting role** (38%) in **promoting democracy worldwide**.

Insights & Analysis

- As Trump has moved quickly to fulfill his campaign promises on these issues, those concerned most with **illegal immigration and the border have fallen** (-3) yet again shifting their top priority back to the **economy** (+2). Consistent with the past few months, **concern with threats to democracy** (22%, +5) **is again at an all-time high**.
- A majority (51%) of voters are confident their **local schools are teaching values** they agree with, though Republicans feel the opposite at only 38% confidence.
- Segmentation analysis identified three groups via machine learning: **GOP Base** (37%), **Dem Base** (43%), and **Ticked-Off, Young, Diverse, Working-Class [TOYDWC]** (20%).
 - As we saw in February, the **TOYDWC voters aren't nearly as ticked-off as last year**, but they are instead are much more **hopeful** about the direction of the country with Trump in the White House (57% Right Direction) – and subsequently moving more towards Trump by the day. 56% have a favorable opinion of him and 60% approve of the job he's doing. They are also more favorable of Elon Musk than the general public.
 - These voters identify as **slightly more Republican** (45%) **than Democratic** (36%).
Young: Two-thirds are under the age of 45. **Diverse**: Nearly half are non-white (25% Black, 18% Hispanic). **Working-Class**: They have the highest rates of employment (93%) but earn the least with over half making less than \$75,000 annually and are the least likely to hold a degree (33%).

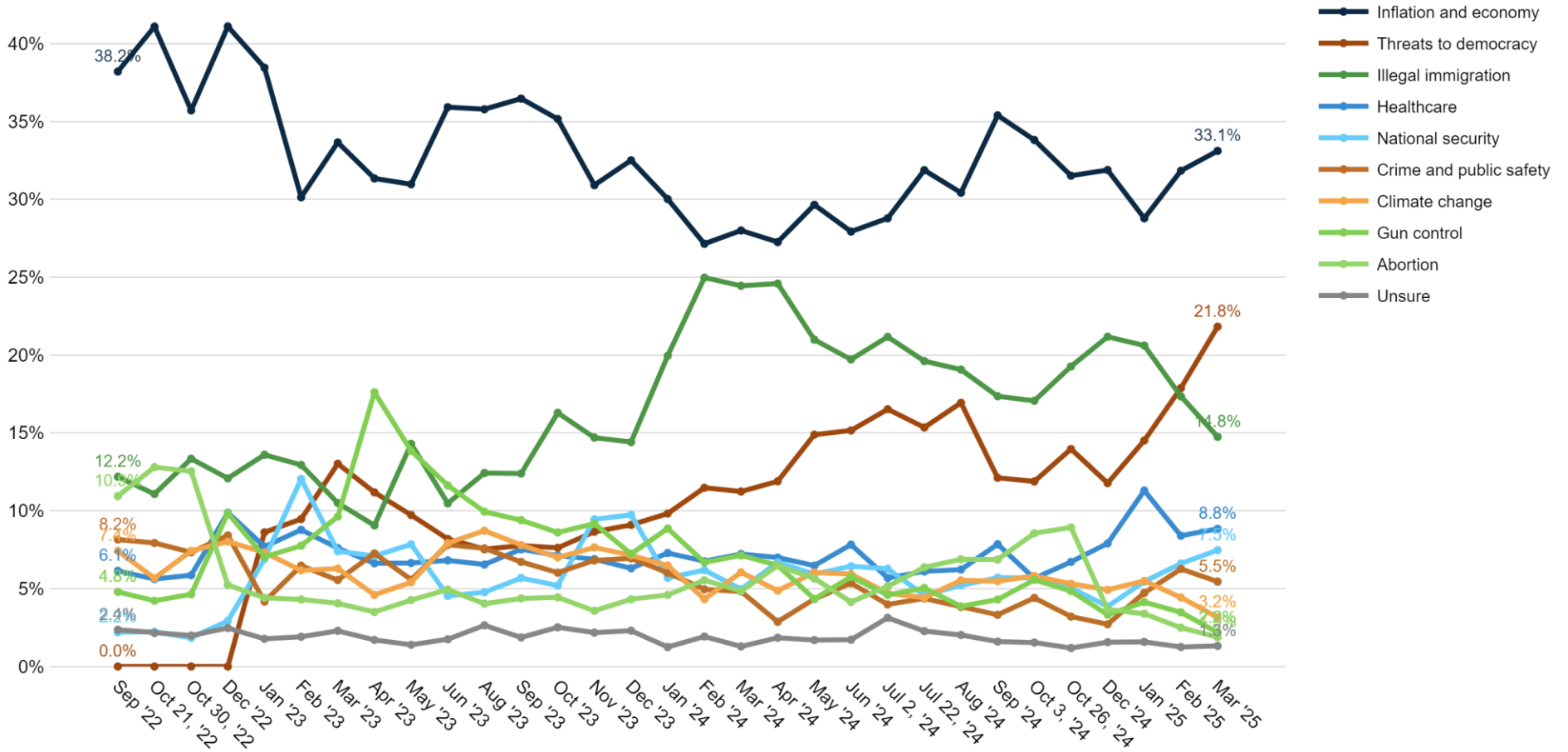

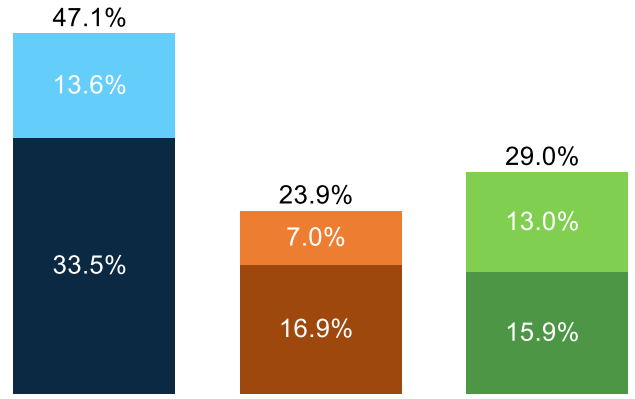

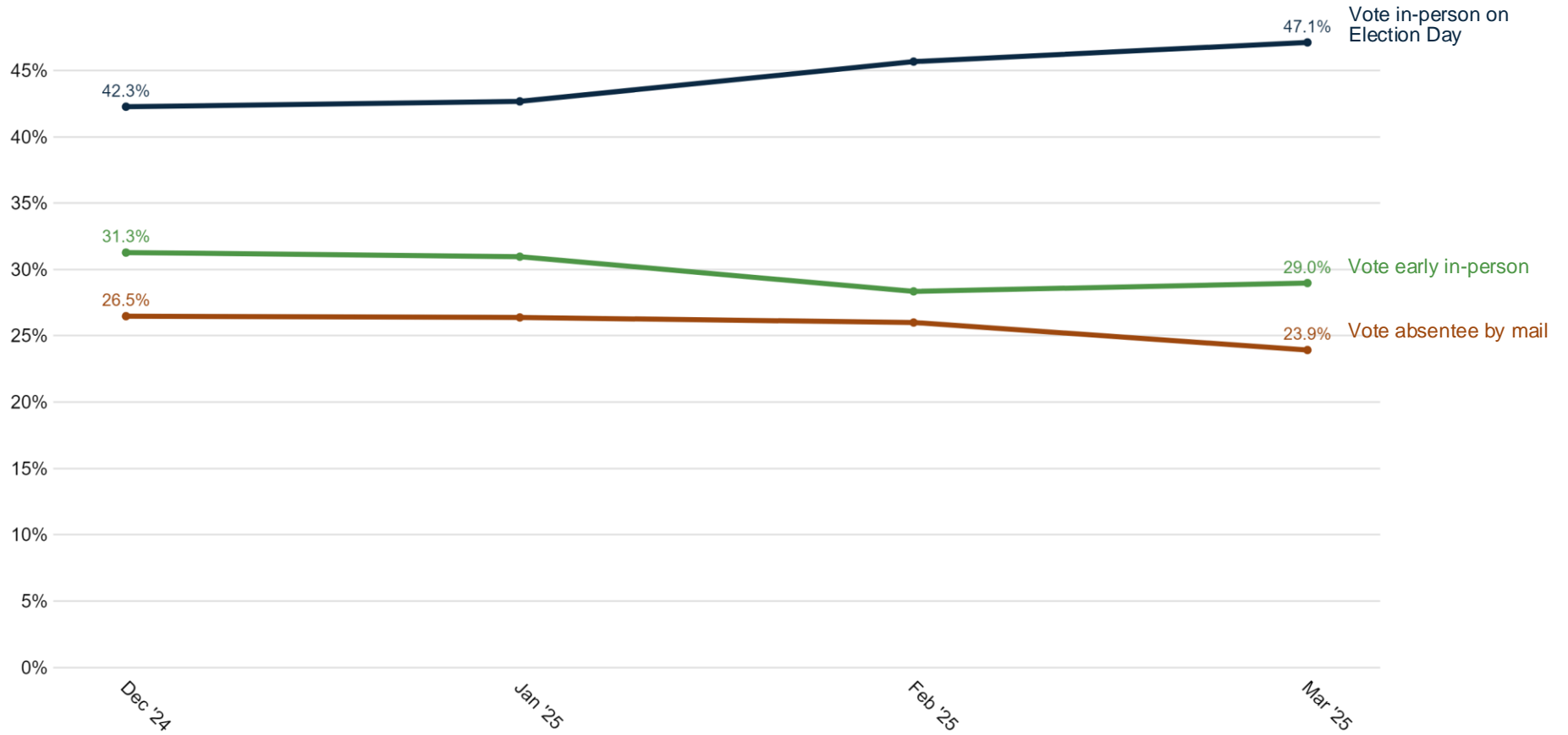

How do you plan to vote in the November 2026 general election for U.S. Congress and state offices?

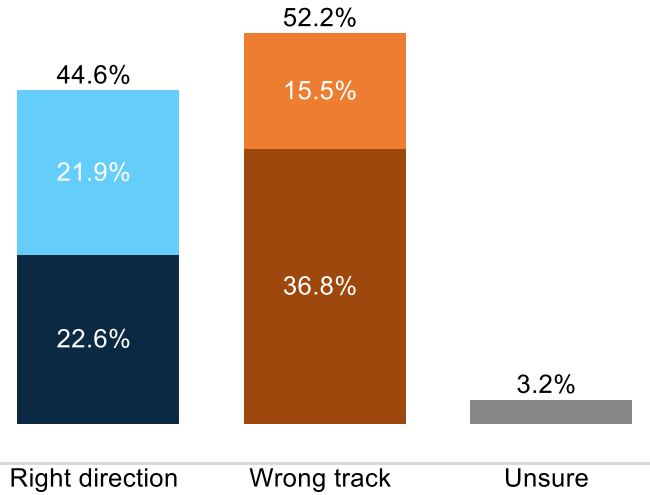

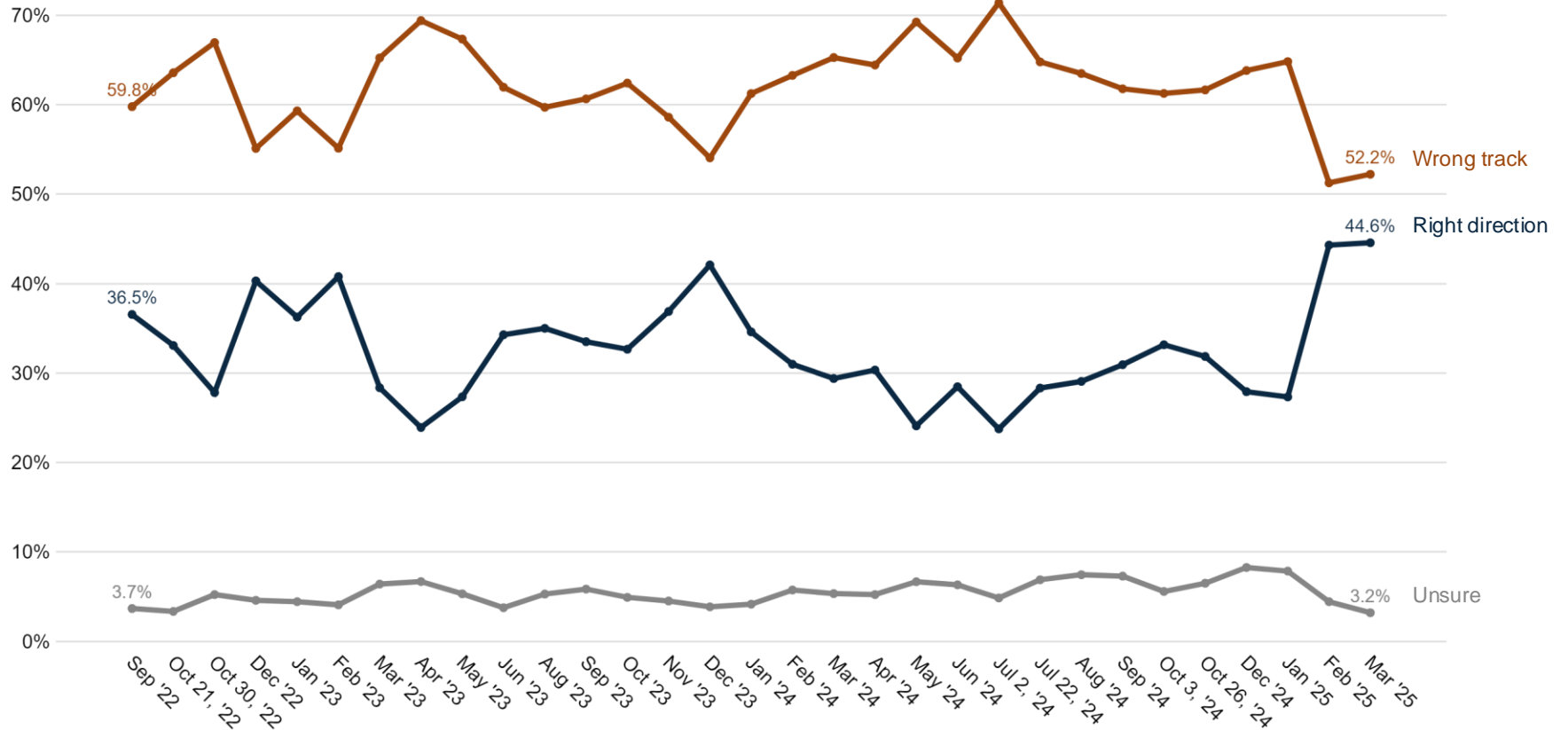

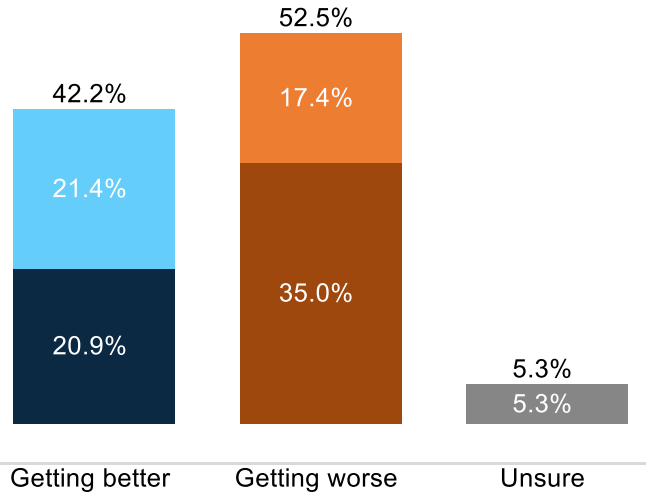

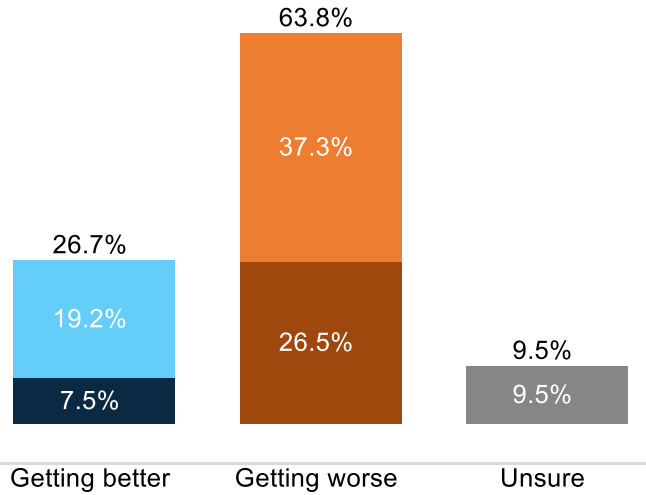

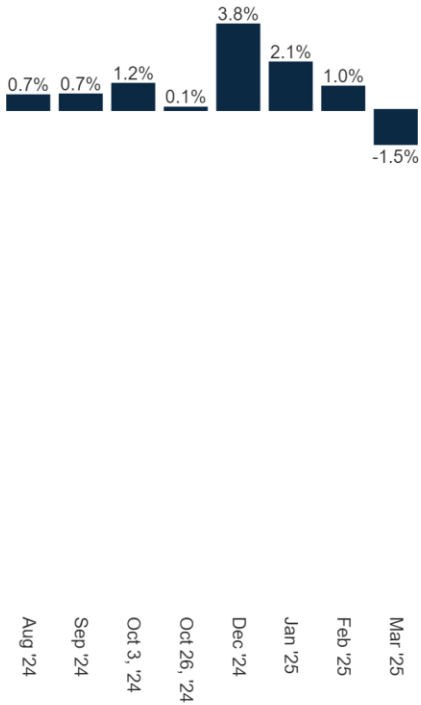

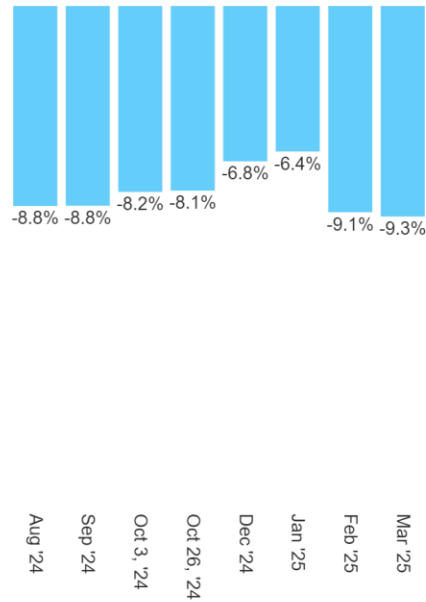

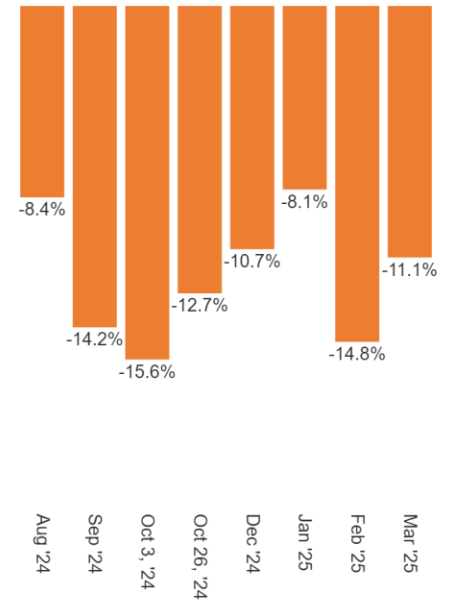

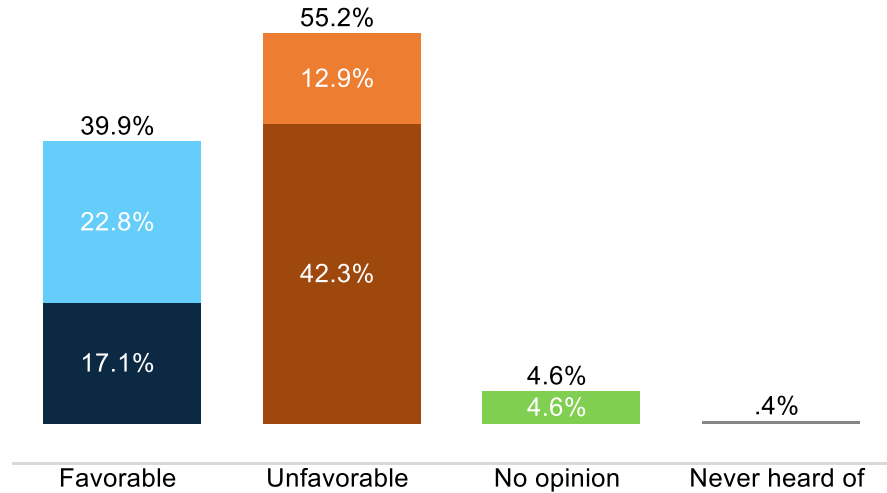

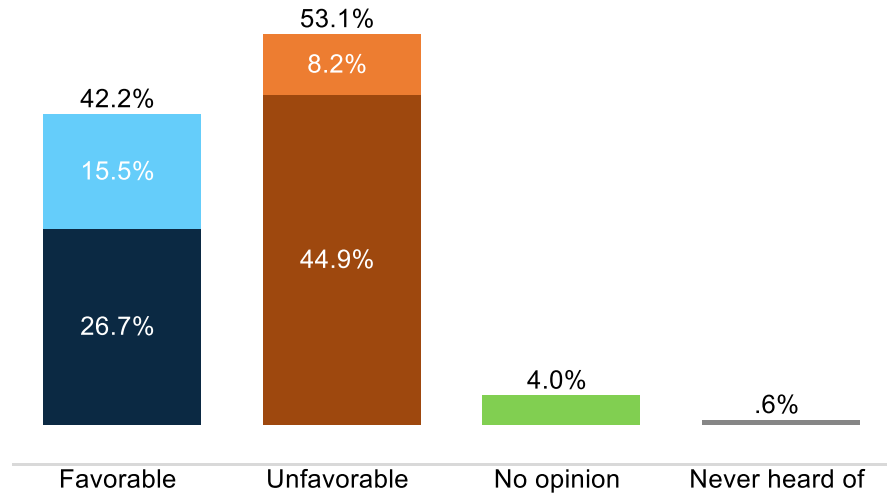

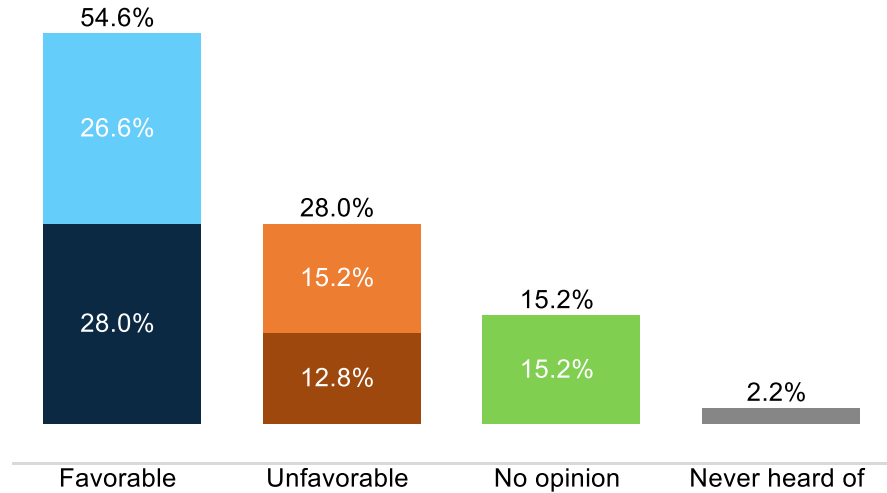

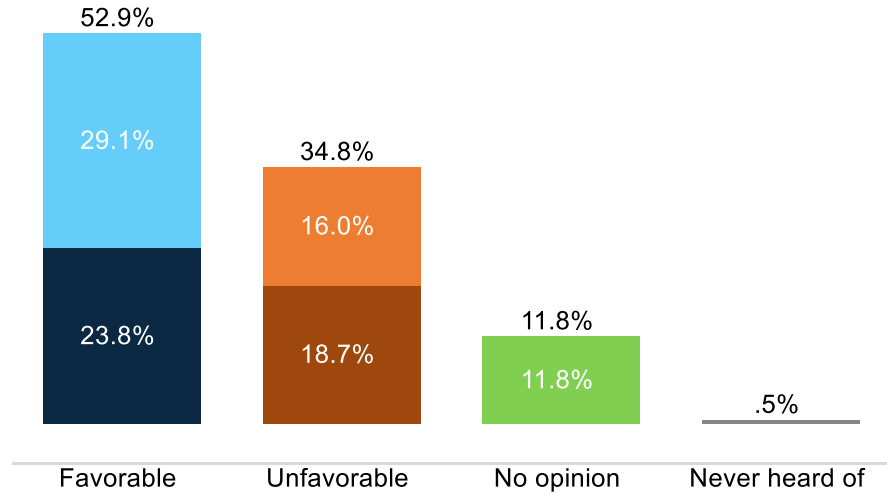

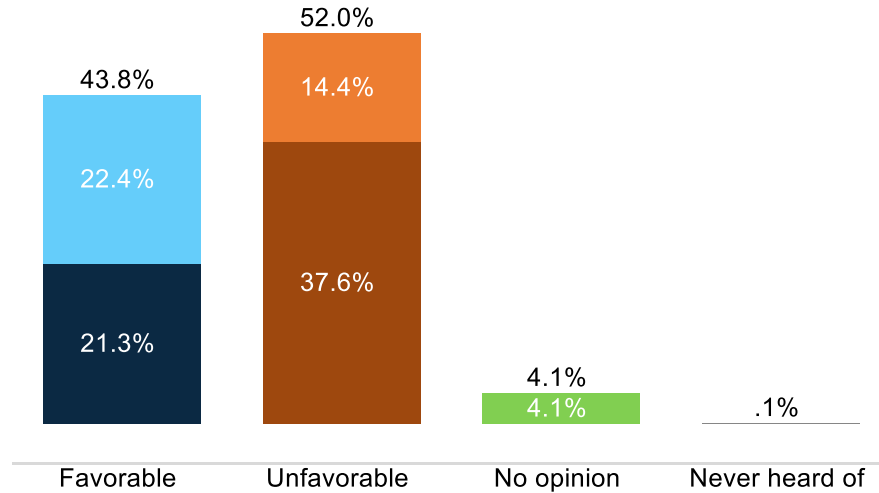

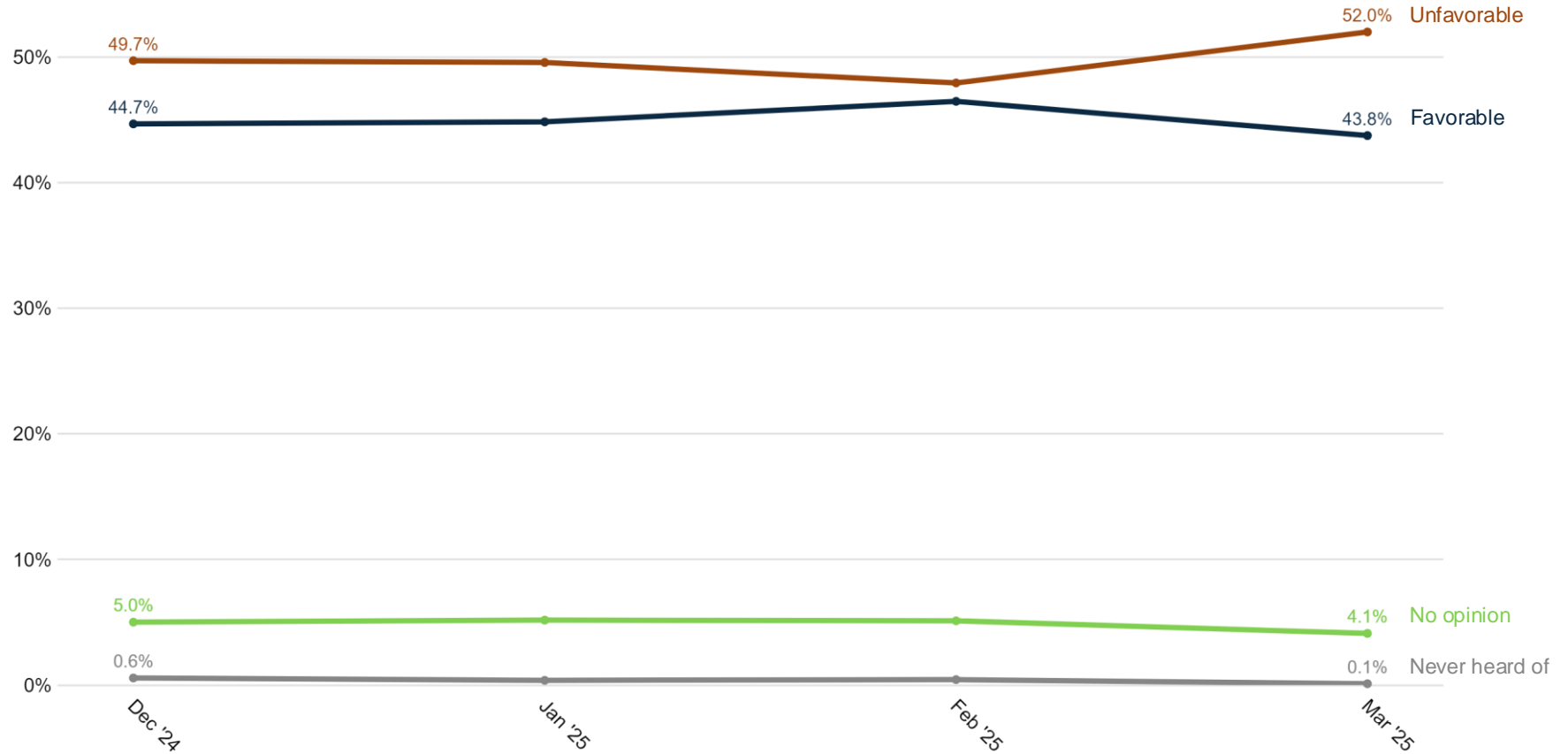

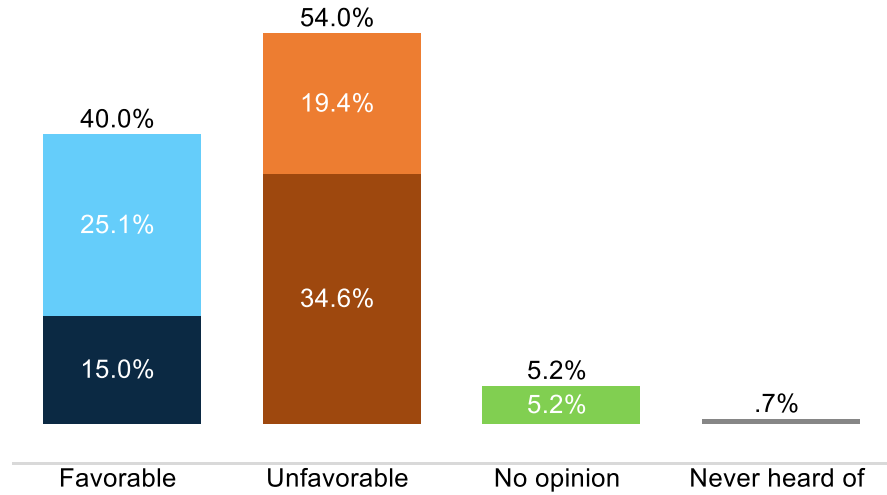

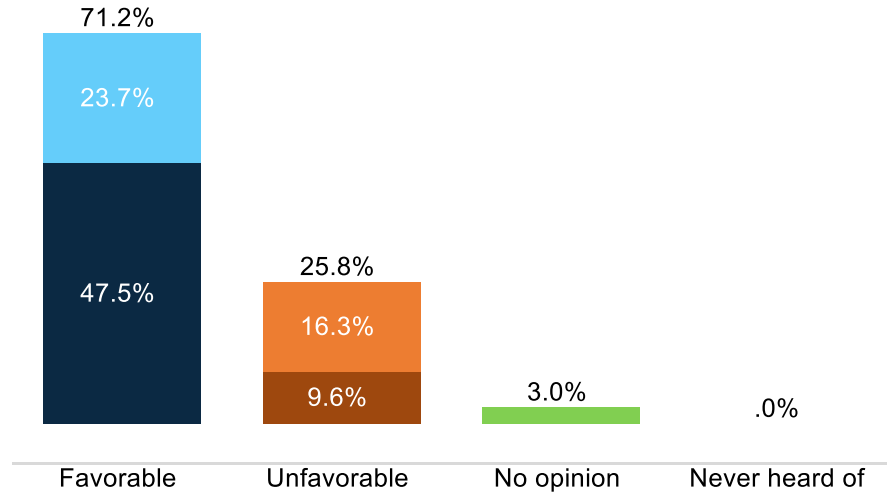

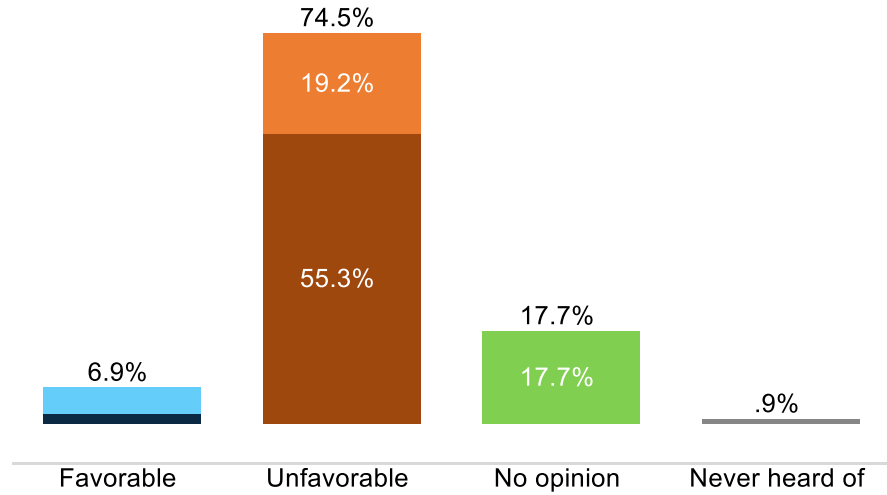

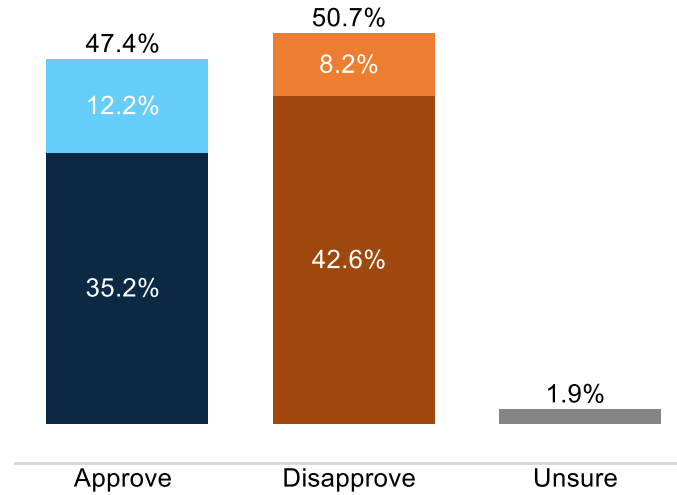

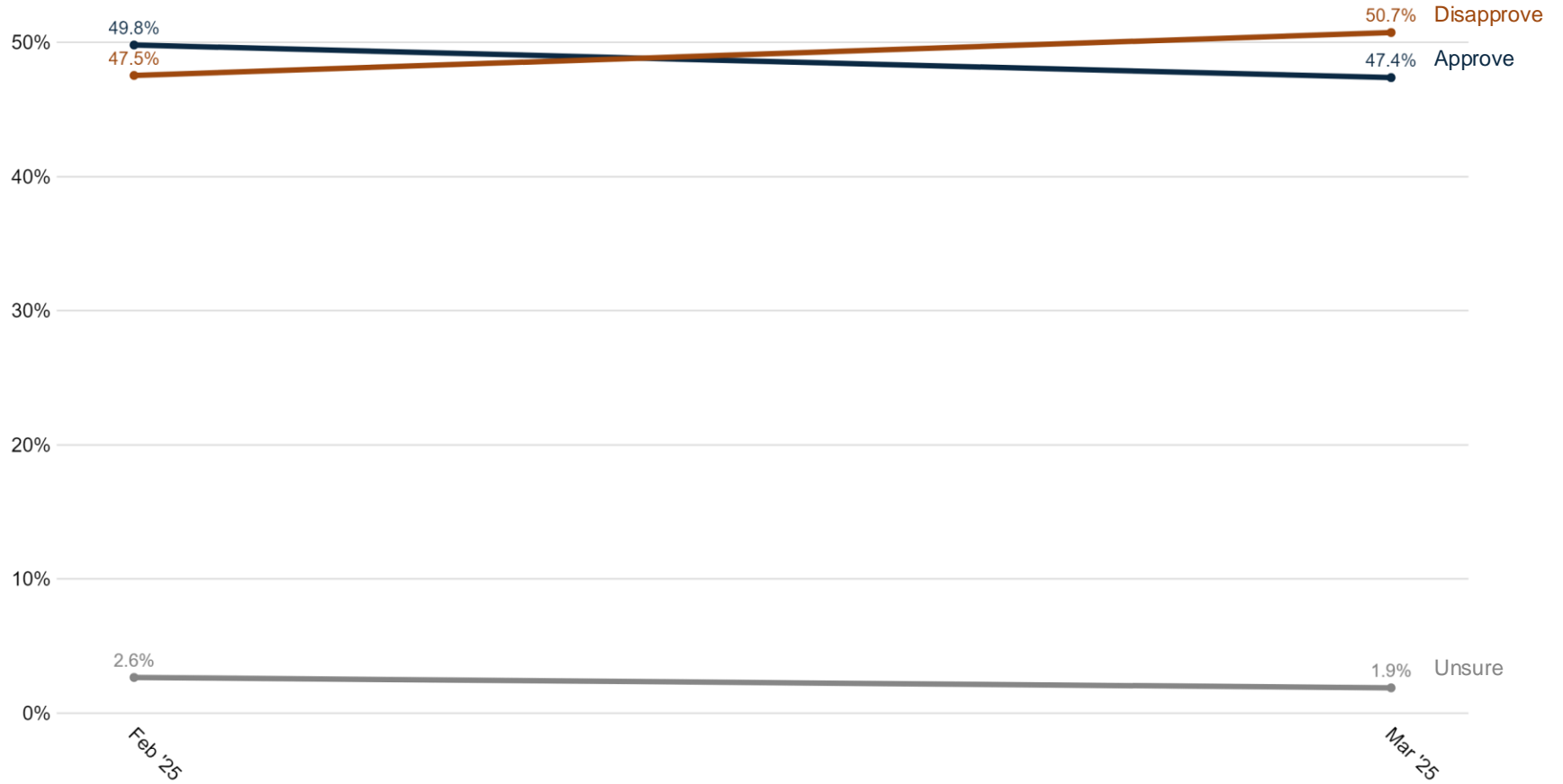

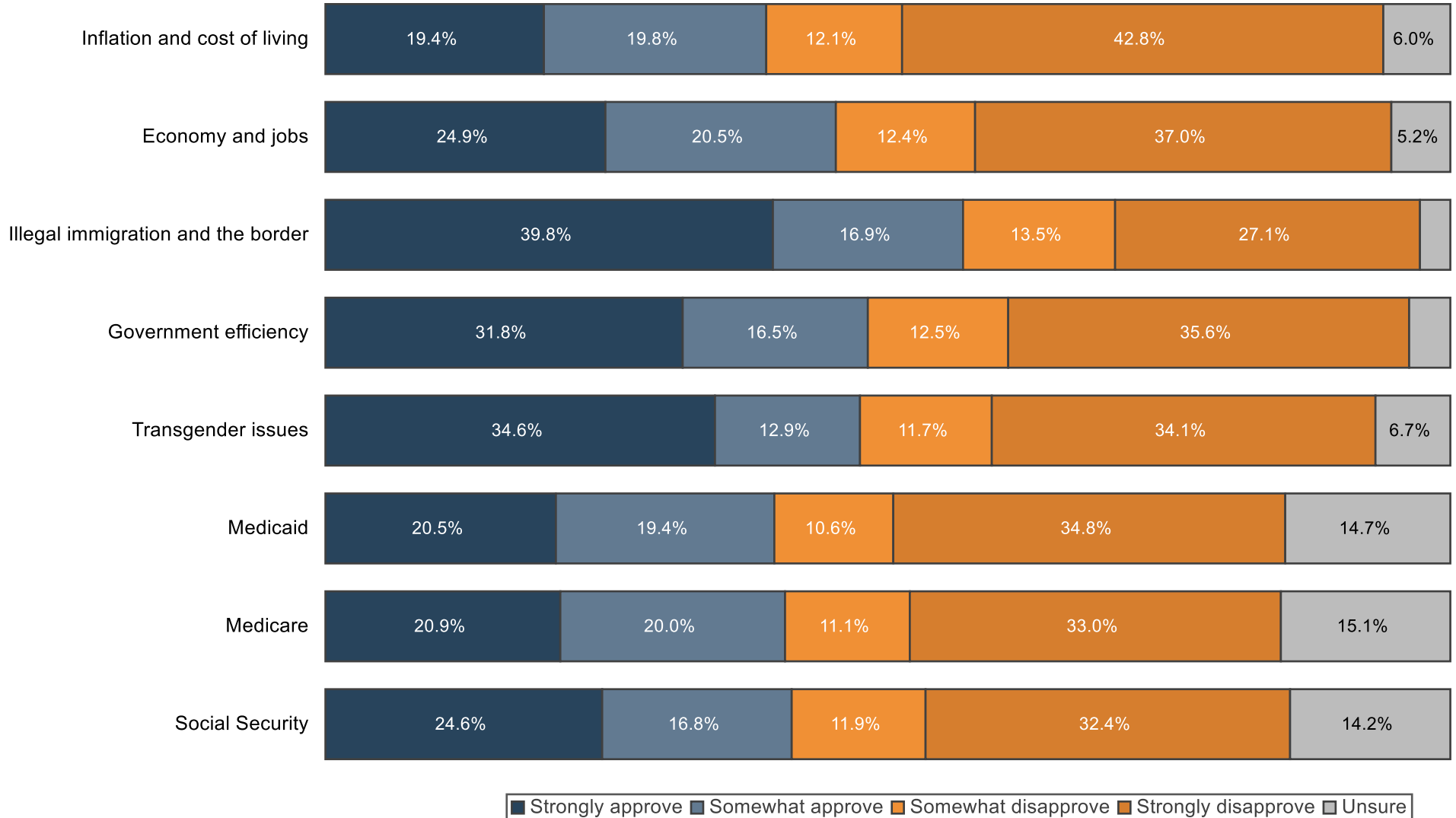
Trend: Trump Job Approval

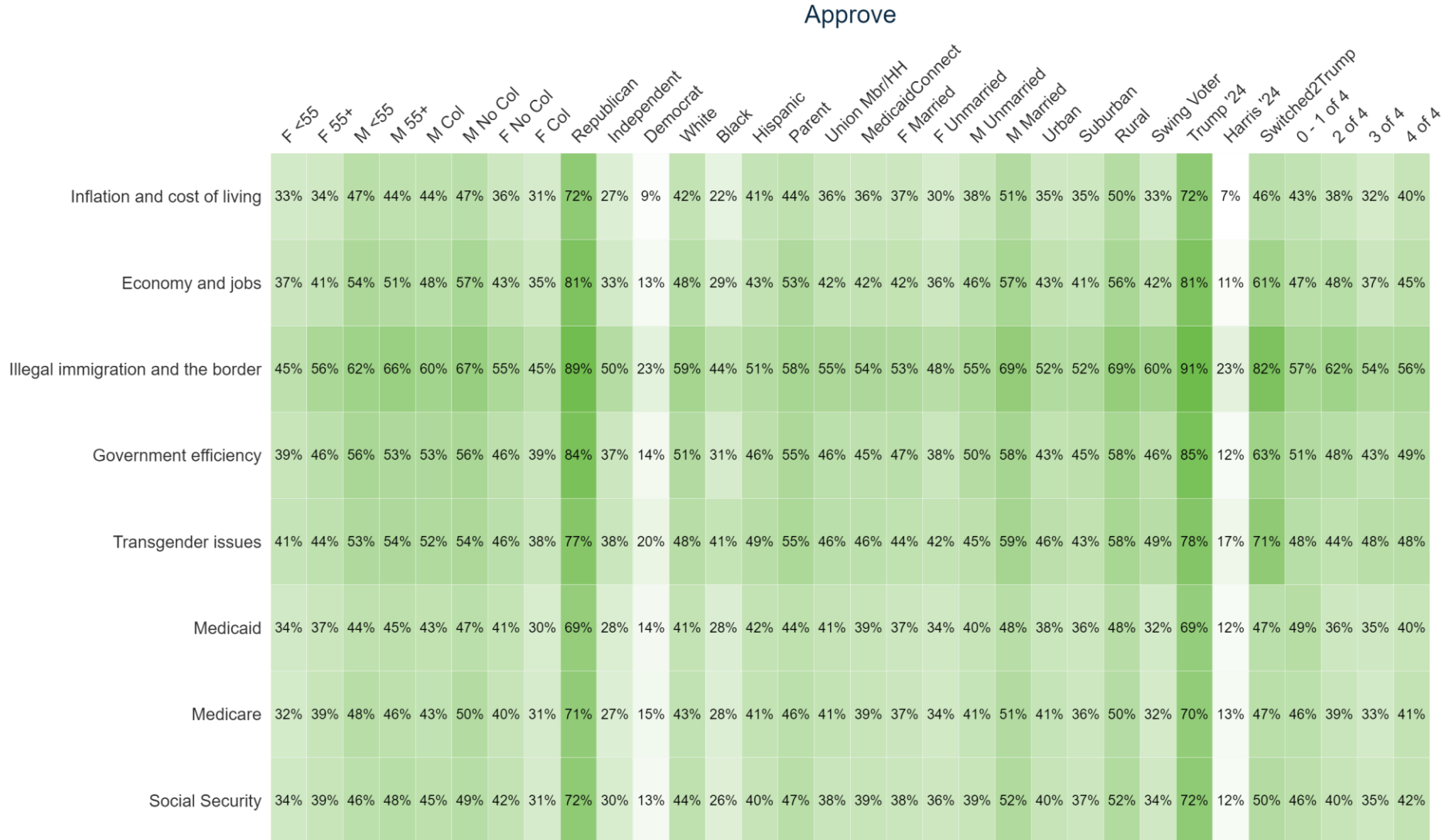

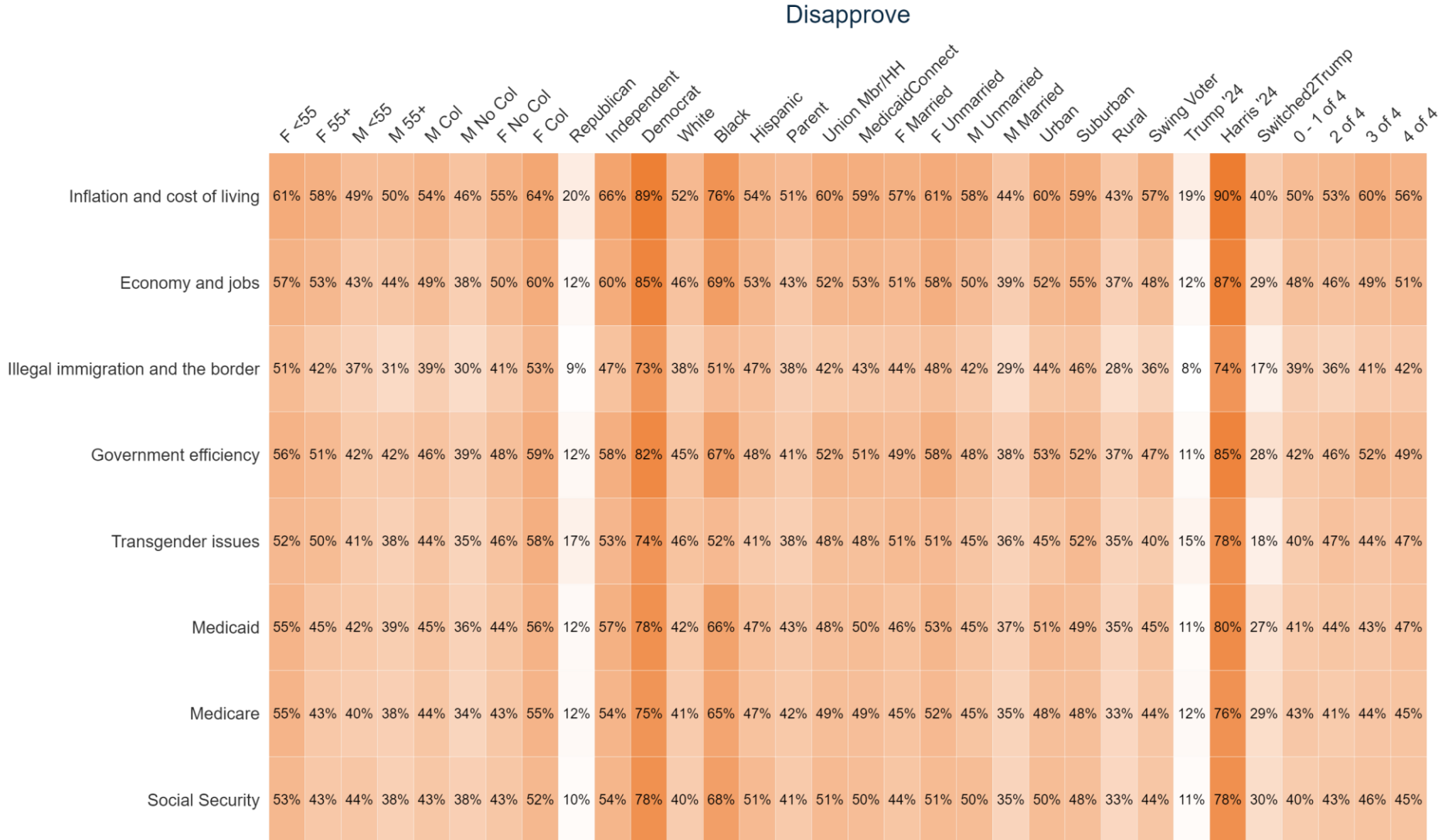

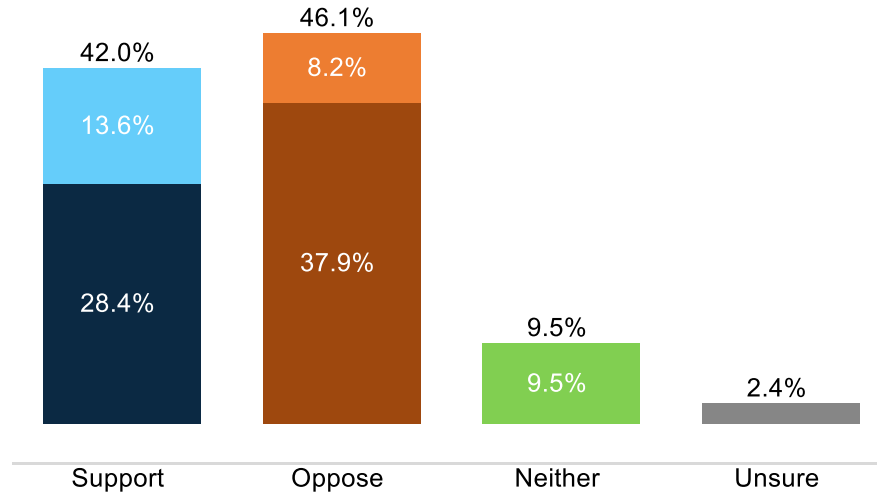
Issues Approval Heatmap - Approve



Issues Approval Heatmap - Disapprove



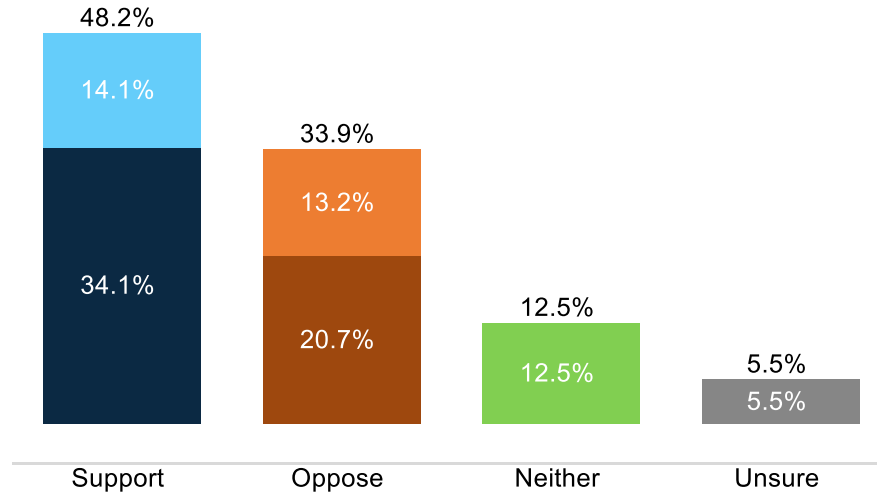

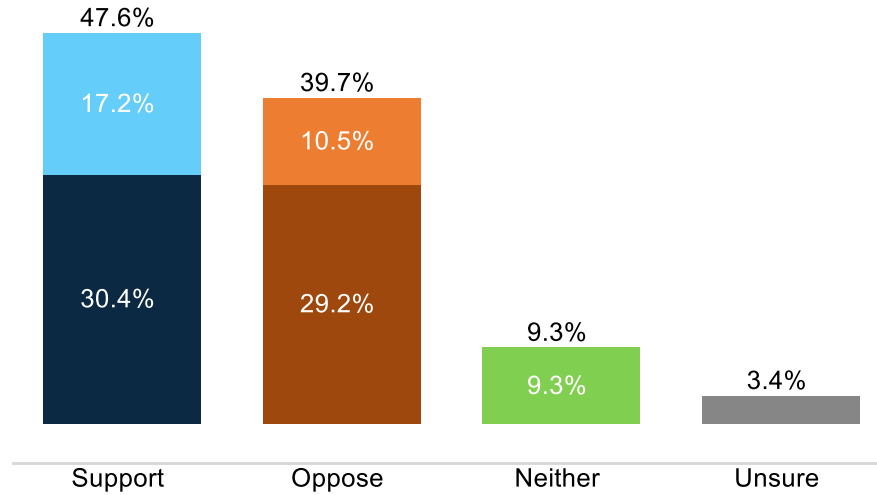

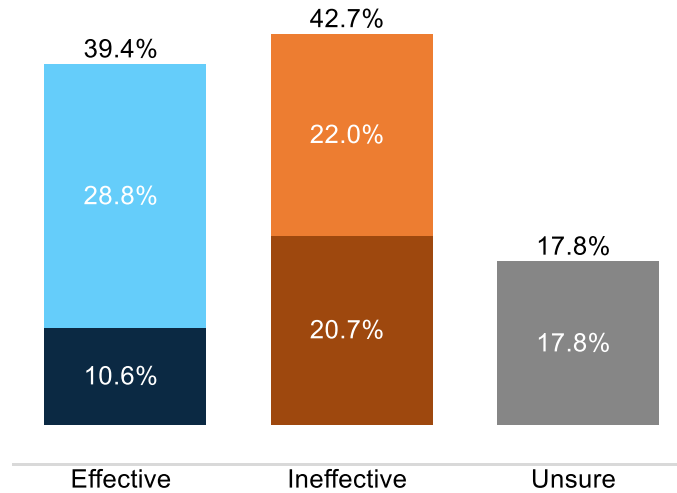

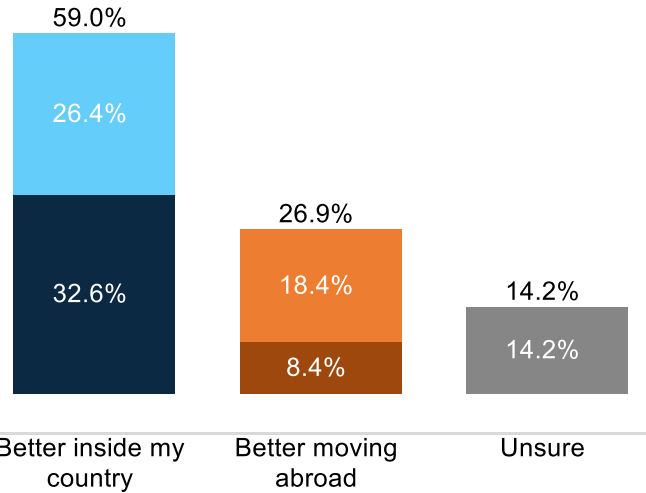

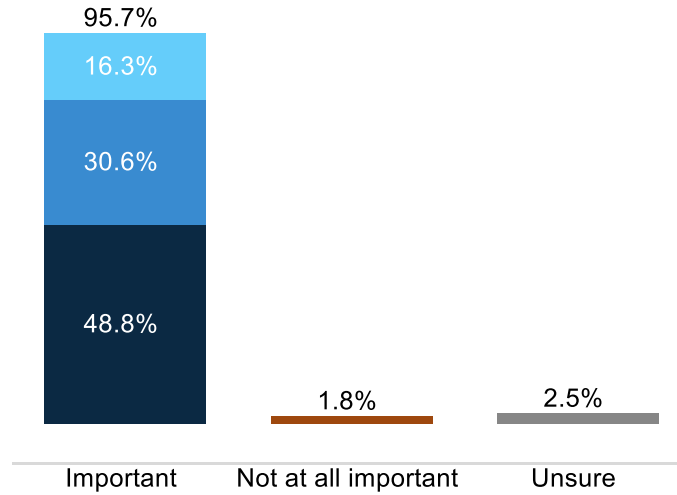

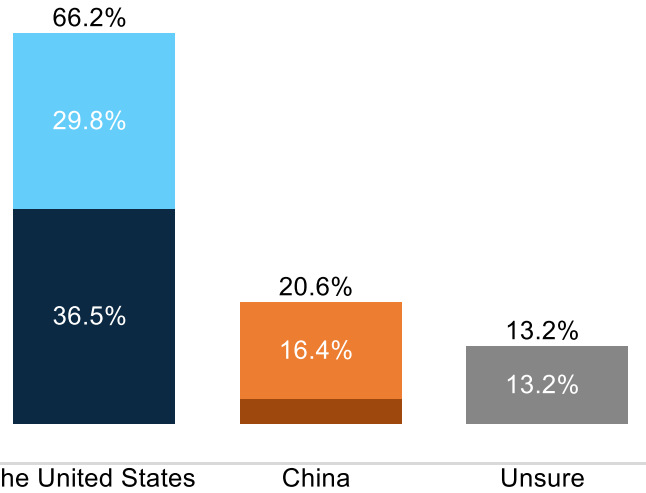

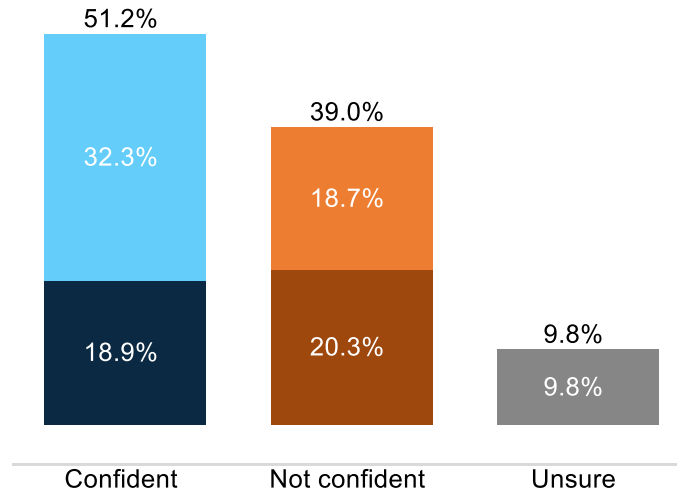

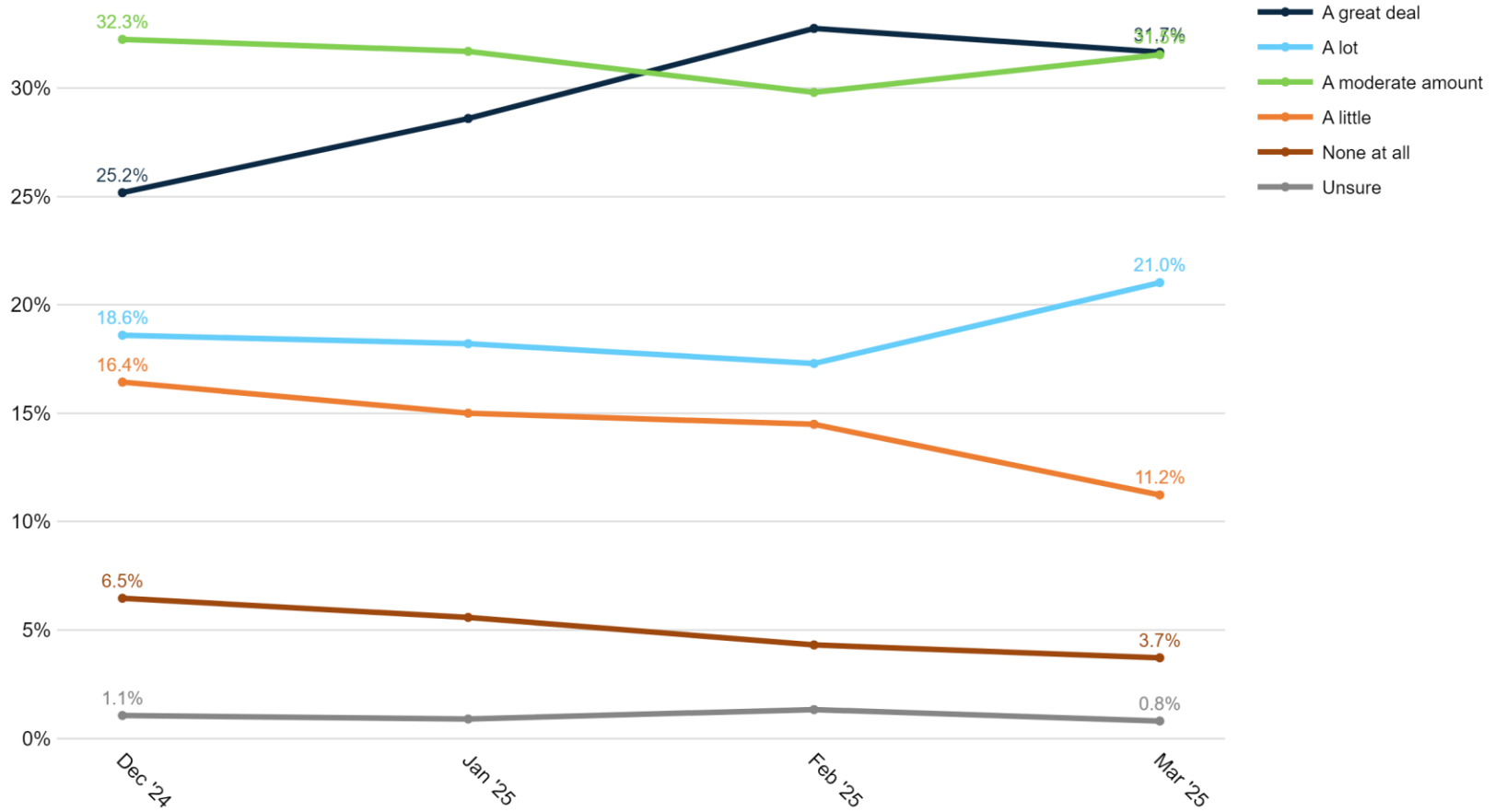

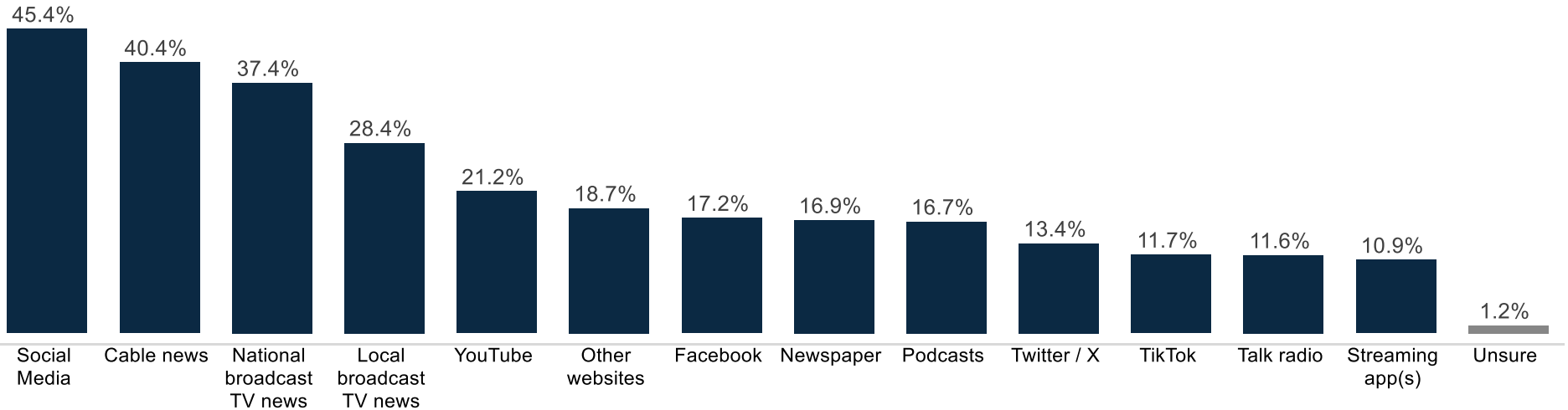
